Defendant Peter C. Card, Jr. has moved for a reduction of his probation. The motion must be denied, because this court has no jurisdiction over defendant's case, now that it has been transferred to the District of Rhode Island. If, as defendant predicts, he does well on probation, it is entirely possible that the supervising probation officer will petition the district court in Rhode Island for early termination of defendant's probation. That decision is a decision to be made by the probation office in Rhode Island.

IT IS ORDERED that defendant's motion for a reduction of his probation term is DENIED for lack of jurisdiction.
