PRETRIAL MOTION
HEARING ORDER

06-CR-205-S

On January 11, 2007, this court held the pretrial motion hearing. Defendant Kevin Lofftin was present with his attorney, Jonas Bednarek. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Elizabeth Altman.

Prior to the hearing, Lofftin filed a motion to suppress evidence. The parties stipulated to the operative facts and will brief the motion as follows: defendant's first brief must be filed and served by January 23, 2007, with the government response due not later than January 30, 2007 and any defense reply filed and served by February 1, 2007. Same-hour service is required. The government must complete disclosure of any expert witnesses not later than January 22, 2007, with reciprocal defense expert disclosure by February 5, 2007. The court denied as unnecessary Lofftin's motion and demand for discovery and inspection (dkt. 13). The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention. I will provide draft voir dire questions and jury instructions closer to their submission deadline for the final pretrial conference.
