PRETRIAL MOTION
HEARING ORDER

06-CR-229-S

On March 1, 2007, this court held a telephonic pretrial motion hearing. Defendant James J. Gallup did not participate personally, but was represented by his attorney, Reed Cornia. Defendant Jesse L. Herrmann did not participate personally, but was represented by his attorney, Gregory Dutch. The government was represented by Assistant U. S. Attorney Robert Anderson.

Prior to the hearing, the defendants filed no pretrial motions (except a motion for leave to file additional pretrial motions that I denied as moot). Attorneys Cornia and Dutch each confirmed that this was a tactical decision made in consultation with their clients after adequate review of the government's disclosures and adequate investigation of the case. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention. Because the parties anticipate resolving this case short of trial, I will wait to provide draft voir dire questions and jury instructions until closer to the submission deadline for the final pretrial conference.
