PRETRIAL MOTION
HEARING ORDER

06-CR-232-C

On January 31, 2007, this court held the pretrial motion hearing. Defendant Michele Hiatt was present with her attorney, Erika Bierma. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney David Reinhard.

Prior to the hearing, Hiatt filed a series of discovery motions/demands. After taking a discovery proffer from the government and inviting input from Attorney Bierma, I granted the motions docketed as 13-15, and denied those docketed as 10-12. The government must disclose expert witnesses not later than February 12, 2007, with reciprocal disclosure of defense expert witnesses by February 26, 2007. Because it is not clear whether this case is going to trial, I will wait to provide draft voir dire questions and jury instructions until closer to the parties' submission deadline for the final pretrial conference. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention.
