Defendant Connes Campbell has filed a motion under 18 U.S.C. § 3582, seeking a modification of the sentence imposed upon him on August 31, 2006. Defendant filed a previous § 3582 motion on March 31, 2008, which was denied on June 5, 2008 because he had been sentenced as career offender and therefore was not eligible for a reduction. On November 6, 2009 defendant filed yet another motion under § 18 U.S.C. 3582, which was denied on November 9, 2009. Defendant appealed that order and the appeal was dismissed on April 27, 2010. The current motion is defendant's third attempt to file a motion under 18 U.S.C. § 3582. Nothing has changed since the entry of both previous orders. Therefore defendant's motion will be DENIED.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that defendant Connes Campbell's motion for a sentence reduction pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3582 is DENIED.
