Pretrial motions must be filed and served not later than March 27, 2007, with the pretrial motion hearing set for March 29, 2007 at 10:30 a.m.

Other dates will be set once a district judge has been assigned to this case following filing of the criminal information. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention.
