JUDGMENT AND

On October 18, 2007, this court held a change of plea and sentencing hearing. Defendant Michael Libke appeared with his attorney, Terry W. Frederick. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Meredith Duchemin.

After engaging in a plea colloquy with the defendant and both attorneys, I accepted Libke's plea of guilty to the operating after revocation charge filed against him, then on the government's motion dismissed the other traffic ticket.

After hearing from both sides and obtaining an allocution from Libke, I sentenced him to 15 days in custody. Libke shall self report on November 30, 2007 at noon to a facility to be designated by the Bureau of Prisons. I recommend that the Bureau of Prisons designate a facility close to Libke's residence. Not later than November 30, 2007, Libke also must pay to the clerk of court a \$50.00 fine and the mandatory \$10.00 assessment.
