MEMORANDUM

Plaintiff has submitted a letter dated April 23, 2007, in which he discusses matters raised in this action. In addition, plaintiff asks for forms for filing a new complaint. The forms are enclosed with this memorandum. However, I cannot consider any of the other matters raised in the letter because plaintiff has not complied with the service requirements of Fed. R. Civ. P. 5. As I told plaintiff in this court's order granting him leave to proceed in forma pauperis, he must serve either the defendants or their lawyer when the name of the lawyer is known with a copy of any communication he submits to the court relating to this case. Because plaintiff does not yet know the name of the lawyer who will be representing

the defendants, he was to have served his communication on each defendant. There is no indication on plaintiff's letter that he did so. Therefore, the letter will be placed in the file but no action will be taken with respect to the matters he raises related to this lawsuit.
