Plaintiff Jevon Jackson, an inmate at the Green Bay Correctional, Institution, Green Bay, Wisconsin, filed this civil action on January 12, 2007 and paid the \$150.00 filing fee. The Court reviews plaintiff's complaint pursuant to 28 U.S.C. 1915A(a) at the defendants' request.

Plaintiff claims that he was denied a commercial photograph, incoming postcards and his legal materials. He alleges that defendant William Pollard, the warden at the Green Bay Correctional Institution, was personally involved in these alleged deprivations of his First Amendment rights. Accordingly, he will be allowed to proceed on these First Amendment claims against defendant Pollard.

Plaintiff has not alleged the personal involvement of Matthew Frank in any of the alleged deprivations. Accordingly, defendant Frank will be dismissed.

## ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff is allowed to proceed on his First Amendment claims against defendant Pollard.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that defendant Matthew J. FRANK is DISMISSED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that defendant Pollard may file his answer not later than twenty days from the date of his receipt of this order.
