This is a proposed civil action, purportedly brought under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Petitioner, who is presently confined at the Sheboygan County Detention Center in Sheboygan, Wisconsin, asks for leave to proceed under the <u>in forma pauperis</u> statute, 28 U.S.C. § 1915. From the financial affidavit petitioner has given the court, I conclude that petitioner is unable to prepay the full fee for filing this lawsuit. Petitioner has paid the initial partial payment required under § 1915(b)(1).

A close review of petitioner's pleading reveals a flaw that must be cured before the court can assess the merits of his claim. Petitioner has not made a demand for the relief he

seeks from this court, which is required under Fed. R. Civ. P. 8(a). Without such a demand, it is not possible to accurately assess petitioner's claims.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that petitioner Pierre Depree Husband may have until April 12, 2007, in which to file an addendum to his complaint in which he lists the relief he is seeking from this court in this case. If, by April 12, 2007, petitioner fails to submit the necessary addendum, his pleading will be dismissed for failure to conform to Fed. R. Civ. P. 8(a).
