On December 7, 2007, plaintiff filed a motion for reimbursement of copying charges. *See* Dkt. 13. Pursuant to the preliminary pretrial conference order, any response to this discovery-related motion was to be filed and served within five calendar days, namely by December 12, 2007. *See* Dkt. 9 at 5. It is now December 18, 2007, and defendants have not filed any response.

Even so, the court will not automatically grant plaintiff's motion; plaintiff must establish a *prima facie* entitlement to the relief requested. He has done so. By virtue of the affidavit of Attorney Steven E. Antolak and the attached documents (*see* dkt. 14), plaintiff has established that defendants agreed to pay the copying cost plaintiff incurred providing documents to defendants and further has established that defendants have yet to pay this bill which was presented on or about August 22, 2007.

Therefore, it is ORDERED that plaintiffs and their attorneys are jointly and severally liable to pay \$2,033.86 to plaintiff's attorney not later than January 18, 2008.
