MEMORANDUM

07-C-208-C

On May 8, 2007, I granted plaintiff Roger Godwin leave to proceed in forma pauperis on his Eighth Amendment claim that defendants Belinda Schrubbe, Charles Larson, “Mark” and Rick Raemisch were deliberately indifferent to his serious medical needs when they refused to take action with respect to his complaints of back pain. Defendants have not yet answered the complaint. Now, however, plaintiff has submitted a document titled “Certified Letter” dated May 9, 2007, together with several attachments. In his letter, he complains that persons not a party to this lawsuit are engaging in behavior that he believes threatens his security and violates state law.

The subject matter of plaintiff's communication has nothing to do with the subject matter raised in the complaint in this lawsuit and. Therefore, although the communication will be placed in the file of this case, it will not be considered. If plaintiff believes his rights under state law are being violated, he is free to file a lawsuit in state court. If he believes his constitutional rights or his rights under federal law are being violated, he will have to file a new lawsuit setting forth his claim.
