As an accommodation to plaintiffs, defendant has moved for a three-week extension of the January 11, 2008 deadline to file summary judgment motions. Defendant seeks to allay plaintiffs' concerns about the timing of certain depositions during the holidays.

Without intending to nickel and dime the parties, I can give most but not all of the requested extension. If I were to give three weeks of the court's review time to the parties, then there is no guarantee that the court will be able to rule on the motion(s) before the trial in May, which is not moving.

So, the motion is granted in part and denied in part: summary judgment motions must be filed and served by January 28, 2008. Responses must be filed and served by February 15, 2008. Replies must be filed and served by February 25, 2008. Same day service is required.
