
Having paid the full amount he was in arrears in case no. 04-C-732-C, petitioner Michael Hill is once again eligible to request pauper status in a new lawsuit. He has done so in this case, in which he claims entitlement to money damages under the Federal Tort Claims Act. In support of his request that this case be reopened, petitioner has submitted proof of his payment of \$209.54 to this court, which is the balance of the sum he owed on his appeal in case no. 04-C-732-C. In addition, petitioner has submitted an updated trust fund account statement so that the court can assess him an initial partial payment of the filing fee in this case.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that petitioner's request to reopen this case is GRANTED. Further, IT IS ORDERED that petitioner may have until July 30, 2007, in

which to submit a check or money order made payable to the clerk of court in the amount of \$38.94, which is the amount he is assessed as an initial partial payment of the \$350 fee for filing this case. Once that payment has been received, the court will screen petitioner's complaint pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2). If, by July 30, 2007, petitioner fails to make the initial partial payment or show cause for his failure to do so, he will be held to have withdrawn this action voluntarily. In that event, the clerk of court is directed to close this file without prejudice to petitioner's filing his case at a later date.
