After I signed the order granting defendants' request for an extension of time until June 5, 2007, in which to respond to plaintiffs' motion for a preliminary injunction, plaintiffs filed a brief in opposition to the request. After reading the opposition brief carefully, I still believe that an extension of time is appropriate. Therefore, the order remains in effect.

Although the parties disagree about the date on which defendants received notice of the motion for a preliminary injunction. even if plaintiffs are correct, the preparation time for defendants is extremely short. Moving the hearing to 9:00 a.m. on Friday, June 8 and giving defendants until noon on June 5 in which to file and serve their opposition papers

seems fair.

If the new date and time for the hearing present problems to plaintiffs, their counsel should call the clerk's office immediately so that the hearing may be moved to a more convenient time for all counsel.
