Pursuant to Rule 37(a)(4), defendant has filed an itemization of expenses incurred in its successful motion to compel discovery. *See* dkt. 11. Plaintiff chose not to object to the reasonableness of this request. The court's independent review establishes that attorney time and expense incurred in the amounts of (4.4 hrs @ \$250/hr) + (0.3 hrs. @ 270/hr), while not a bargain, are not unreasonable for the nature of the motion filed, the relief sought or the results obtained.

Therefore, it is ORDERED that plaintiff and his attorney are jointly and severally liable to pay \$1181 to defendant's attorneys not later than October 1, 2007.
