Plaintiff filed a motion to compel discovery (dkt. 37) that defendants oppose on several grounds, including that litigation was stayed until plaintiff decided on which claims he wished to proceed (dkt. 39). Now that plaintiff has made his choice (dkt. 38), it is his obligation to advise the court whether he wishes to pursue his motion to compel. The court will take no action unless the plaintiff files a supplement to his pending motion. The state may have five calendar days within which to file a response to any supplement. If plaintiff has not filed a supplement by January 16, 2008, the court will consider the pending discovery motion abandoned.
