In an order dated July 9, 2007, I granted plaintiff leave to proceed in forma pauperis on his claim that defendants Jeff Endicott and Ms. Gunderson have violated his rights under the Americans with Disabilities Act and the Eighth Amendment by refusing to allow him to use a handicapped shower stall while he is incarcerated at the Redgranite Correctional Institution. It has come to my attention that section 1.a. of the order portion of the July 9 opinion includes the name of a person not named as a defendant in this lawsuit, rather than the names of defendants Endicott and Gunderson against whom I allowed plaintiff to proceed.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that section 1.a. of the July 9, 2007 order is AMENDED

to read:

1. Petitioner Kenneth Awe's request to proceed <u>in forma pauperis</u> is a. GRANTED with respect to his claims that respondents Jeff Endicott and Ms. Gunderson exhibited deliberate indifference to his serious medical needs and violated his rights under the ADA by prohibiting him from using the handicapped shower stall.

In all other respects, the July 9, 2007 order stands.
