Petitioner Pierre Depree Husband, a prisoner at the Racine Youth Offender Correctional Facility in Racine, Wisconsin, has submitted a proposed complaint. He requests leave to proceed in forma pauperis. A decision on the request will be delayed until petitioner pays an initial partial payment of the filing fee as required by 28 U.S.C. § 1915(b) and the 1996 Prison Litigation Reform Act. Petitioner's initial partial payment cannot be calculated at this time because petitioner has not submitted a trust fund account statement covering the six-month period immediately preceding the filing of his complaint, as he is required to do under §1915.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that petitioner may have until August 3, 2007, in

which to submit a trust fund account statement for the six month period before he filed his complaint. If, by August 3, petitioner fails to respond to this order, I will assume that he wishes to withdraw this action voluntarily and the clerk of court is directed to close this file without prejudice to petitioner's filing his case at a later date.
