As requested in this court's July 23, 2007 order, petitioner Pierre Depree Husband has submitted a certified copy of his trust fund account statement for the six-month period immediately preceding the filing of his complaint in this case. From the statement, I conclude that he owes an initial partial payment of the \$350 fee for filing his complaint in the amount of \$3.85. A check in the amount of \$3.00 accompanied petitioner's statement. Therefore, petitioner must pay the balance of \$.85 before the court can screen his complaint pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2).

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that petitioner may have until August 24, 2007, in which to submit a check or money order made payable to the clerk of court in the amount of \$.85. If, by August 24, 2007, petitioner fails to pay the remainder of the initial partial payment he owes or show cause for his failure to do so, he will be held to have withdrawn this action voluntarily. In that event, the clerk of court is directed to close this file without prejudice to petitioner's filing his case at a later date.
