In an order dated September 24, 2007, I denied plaintiff Pierre Husband's "supplemental to complaint", which I construed as an unrequested reply to defendants' answer. In his reply, plaintiff sought permission to make "corrections" and include "additional material pursuant to [Wis. Stat.] § 893.80(3)". Now plaintiff has filed a document titled "reason for delay and notice of motion and motion to considerate [sic] waiving limitation rule" which appears to be a second reply to defendants' answer. For the reasons explained in this court's order of September 24, 2007 (which appears to have crossed

in the mail with plaintiff's recent submission), I will deny plaintiff's motion.

ORDER
