On March 14, 2007, this court held the pretrial motion hearing. Defendant Calvin Williams was present with his attorney, Richard Wells, standing in for retained counsel Bridget Boyle-Saxton. Defendant Charles Coker was present with his attorney, Erika Bierma. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Robert Anderson.

Williams filed no pretrial motions. Attorney Wells stated that this was a tactical decision made in consultation with Williams after adequate review of the government's disclosures and adequate independent investigation of this case.

Coker filed a series of discovery motions and demands. After taking a discovery proffer and discussing the motions with both sides, I granted the motion docketed as 28, denied 27 and 29-32. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention.

Because it is too early to tell whether these defendants will go to trial, I will wait to provide draft voir dire questions and jury instructions until closer to the parties' submission deadline for the final pretrial conference.
