On June 21, 2007 this court convened the scheduled evidentiary hearing on defendant Calvin Bruce's motion to suppress physical evidence. As outlined in the previous telephonic conversations between counsel and the court, Bruce had subpoenaed Endia Matthews to testify as to alleged coercion of her consent to search the residence in which Bruce now is claiming a privacy interest. Matthews honored the subpoena by appearing for the hearing, but after consulting with the federal defender, asserted her Fifth Amendment privilege against self-incrimination and declined to testify (this assertion was not made on the record but was reported by Bruce's attorney, Anthony Delyea). Bruce had no other witnesses on the issue of alleged coercion, so we ended the hearing without taking any testimony.
