PRETRIAL MOTIONS  
HEARING ORDER

On April 25, 2007, this court held the pretrial motions hearing. Defendant Diaunte Shields was present with his attorney, Michael Lieberman. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Meredith Duchemin.

Prior to the hearing, Shields filed no pretrial motions. Attorney Lieberman confirmed on the record this was a tactical decision he made in consultation with Shields after adequate review of the government's disclosures and adequate investigation of this case. *See also* Dkt. 13. The government provided a discovery proffer; the parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention. Because this case is unlikely to go to trial, I will wait to provide draft voir dire questions and jury instructions until closer to the parties' submission deadline for the final pretrial conference.
