On August 30, 2007 this court held a telephonic pretrial motion hearing. Defendant Bruce Rhodes did not participate personally but was represented by his attorney, Brian Mullins. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Elizabeth Altman.

Prior to the hearing Rhodes filed a motion to quash the search warrant and suppress evidence, accompanied by his legal brief. See dkt. 10. The government's response must be filed and served by September 11, 2007, with any reply by September 21, 2007. Rhodes, by counsel, did not need a discovery proffer on the record and had no other substantive matters to bring to the court's attention. Because the suppression motion is essentially case dispositive, I will wait to provide draft voir questions and jury instructions until closer to the

parties' submission deadline for the final pretrial conference.
