On August 16, 2007, this court held the pretrial motion hearing. Defendant David Carmel was present with his attorney, T. Christopher Kelly. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Laura Przybylinski Finn.

Prior to the hearing, Carmel filed a series of discovery motions and requests along with several substantive motions. After taking a discovery proffer from the government and discussing the motions with both sides, I granted the motions docketed as 20 and 29, denied 19 and 23-28, took no action on 15, 20 and 21, and set for briefing 16-18. At Attorney Kelly's request, we set a tight briefing calendar: defense brief(s) must be filed and served not later than August 20, 2007, with the government response(s) filed and served by August 27, 2007, and any reply filed and served by August 29, 2007. The parties may e-file their briefs with the court after hours if necessary. The government must complete disclosure of expert witnesses not later than August 27, 2007, with reciprocal defense expert disclosure by September 10, 2007. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention.

Because it is not clear whether this case will go to trial, I will wait to provide draft voir dire and jury instructions until closer to the parties' submission deadline for the final pretrial conference.
