PRETRIAL MOTION
HEARING ORDER

07-CR-027-S

On May 25, 2007, this court held the pretrial motion hearing. Defendant Gregory Blum was present with his attorney, T. Christopher Kelly. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Meredith Duchemin.

Prior to the hearing, Blum filed a series of discovery motions and requests. After taking a discovery proffer from the government and discussing the motions with both sides, I granted the motion docketed as 12, denied 11 and 13-17, took no action on the requests docketed as 18-19, and set briefing on the motions docketed as 9-10. Blum must file his first brief not later than June 4, 2007 with noon service on the government. The government must file and serve its response not later than June 8, 2007. Blum must file and serve any reply not later than five calendar days after receipt of the government's response. The government must complete disclosure of expert witnesses not later than June 4, 2007

with reciprocal defense expert disclosure not later than June 18, 2007. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention.
