HEARING ORDER

07-CR-031-S-03

On May 16, 2007, this court held the pretrial motion hearing. Defendant Arthur Conner was present with his attorney, Gregory Dutch. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Paul Connell.

The first order of business was Attorney Dutch's motion to continue the trial date because of unexpected imminent surgery. Conner asked that Dutch be kept on the case, and the government did not oppose the brief continuance. Accordingly, the current schedule is stricken in favor of these dates:

Submissions for final pretrial conference: July 20, 2007 at noon.

Final Pretrial Conference: July 23, 2007 at 2:00 p.m.

Final Hearing: July 25, 2007 at 3:30 p.m.

Jury Selection: July 30, 2007 at 9:00 a.m.

Jury Trial: August 1, 2007 at 9:00 a.m.

After taking a discovery proffer from the government and discussing both of Conner's discovery motions with the parties (dks. 45 and 46), I denied both as unnecessary. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention.
