Prior to the hearing, Heckel filed a series of discovery motions. After taking a discovery proffer from the government and discussing the motions with both sides, I granted the motions docketed as 8 and 13, and denied the rest. The government must complete its disclosure of expert witnesses by July 9, 2007, with any defense expert witnesses disclosed not later than July 23, 2007. The parties had no other substantive matters to bring to the court's attention. Because the parties anticipate resolving this matter short of trial, I will wait to provide the draft voir dire questions and jury instructions until closer to the parties' submission deadline for the final pretrial conference.
