PRETRIAL MOTION  
HEARING ORDER

On August 22, 2007, this court held the pretrial motion hearing and a hearing on the government's motion to detain defendant Jason Visor. Visor was present with his attorney, Michael Lieberman. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Rita Rumbelow.

Visor filed no pretrial motions for reasons explained in Attorney Lieberman's August 16, 2007 letter to the court (dkt. 8). After taking a discovery proffer, I ordered the government to complete disclosure of expert witnesses not later than September 4, 2007, with reciprocal defense expert disclosure by September 17, 2007. That concluded the pretrial motion hearing. I will provide draft voir dire questions and jury instructions closer to the parties' submission deadline for the final pretrial conference.

The court then held the detention hearing; I granted the government's motion for reasons stated in a separately-entered order.
