PRETRIAL MOTION
HEARING ORDER

07-CR-089-S

On September 13, 2007, this court held the pretrial motion hearing and an evidentiary hearing. Defendant Michael Mikulewicz was present with his attorney, Stephen Meyer. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Robert Anderson.

Prior to the hearing, Mikulewicz filed a series of discovery and substantive motions. After taking a discovery proffer from the government and discussing the motions with both sides, I denied the discovery motion (dkt. 13) as unnecessary, but set expert disclosure deadlines of October 9, 2007 for the government and October 22, 2007 for Mikulewicz. All the remaining motions (dks. 6, 8, 10 and 12) shall be briefed. Mikulewicz shall have until September 24, 2007, within which to provide his first brief(s) in support; the government's response is due October 5, 2007; any reply must be filed and served by October 12, 2007. Same day service of all briefs is required. I have directed the government to contact Brandy Colegrove and Charles Frank (or his attorney) to alert them to the pending motions

involving discovery of their information. Colegrove and Frank each have a right to be heard on Mikulewicz's motions if they wish, but are not required to participate. The court will not base its ruling on their decision not to be heard. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention.
