On August 9, 2007, this court held a hearing on defendant Walter J. Fox's motion for release on conditions. As discussed at the hearing, I continue to accept pretrial service's recommendation that intensive inpatient treatment is necessary, particularly in the absence of an opinion by a qualified AODA specialist to the contrary. Fox's dilemma right now is that the assessor he has contacted is not willing to come to the jail to perform the assessment and this court does not "furlough" detainees for this purpose. Even if an assessor recommended outpatient treatment, the court cannot and will not promise in advance that it would accept the recommendation. Regardless, at this point the court's concerns remain unabated.

Therefore, it is ordered that the defendant's motion for release is denied without prejudice.
