On August 30, 2007, this court held a telephonic pretrial motion hearing. Defendant Vincent Corner did not participate personally but was represented by his attorney, Brian Mullins. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney Rita Rumbelow.

Prior to the hearing Corner filed a motion to compel disclosure of specific exculpatory information, if it exists. The government agrees that such information is discoverable and has assigned its case agent to double-check with anyone who might have heard Tecora Brown claim ownership of the crack cocaine charged against Corner in this case. That said, I am granting the motion as a place holder in the record. Corner, by counsel, did not require a discovery proffer on the record and had no other issues to bring to the court's attention. Because this case is unlikely to go to trial, I will wait to provide draft voir dire questions and

jury instructions to the parties until closer to their submission deadline for the final pretrial conference.
