ORDER

Defendant Sherry Anne La Tourneau has filed a motion for adjustment of payment of restitution. In support of her motion, defendant argues that the Bureau of Prisons has been deducting payments on her restitution obligation and that these deductions are causing her family to have to send money to her for phone calls, hygiene items and other necessities. Defendant's motion will be DENIED.

It is appropriate and well within the Bureau of Prisons' discretion to require inmates to make payments on their court-ordered obligations. It may be a hardship for defendant to pay restitution, but it is a hardship for which she is responsible.

ORDER

Defendant Sherry Ann La Tourneau's motion for an adjustment of payment of restitution is DENIED.
