Defendant Deandre Bishop has asked for appointment of counsel to assist him in filing a motion for a sentencing reduction under 18 U.S.C. § 3582. Dkt. #66. He contends that because he was sentenced for possession with intent to distribute cocaine base (crack cocaine) and the guidelines for crimes involving distribution of crack cocaine have been lowered and given retroactive effect, he is entitled to a reduction in his sentence. He is mistaken. Under 21 U.S.C. § 841(b)(1), defendant was sentenced to a mandatory term of ten years. That term was set by statute and can be changed only by an Act of Congress. It is not affected by changes in the sentencing guidelines.

ORDER

Defendant Deandre Bishop's motion for appointment of counsel is DENIED as unnecessary.
