ORDER

07-cr-31-jcs-02

Defendant Harold Hamilton has filed a motion pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3582, seeking a reduction of the sentence imposed upon him on June 5, 2007. Defendant was sentenced originally to a term of 65 months; he seeks a reduction to 60 months, which is the statutory minimum applicable to his offense. The government does not oppose the motion.

Defendant's original offense level was 30 because the offense and relevant conduct involved at least 35 grams but less than 50 grams of cocaine base. Under the amended guidelines, his offense level is 28. This is reduced by three levels for acceptance of responsibility. With an offense level of 25 and a criminal history category of I, defendant has an advisory guideline range of 57-71 months. His reduced sentence will be within the guideline range.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that the judgment and commitment order entered on June 6, 2007 is AMENDED to provide that the sentence imposed on defendant Harold Hamilton is reduced to 60 months. In all other respects, the judgment and commitment order remains as entered on June 6, 2007.
