SCHEDULING ORDER

3:07-CR-66-BBC

On February 4, 2008, this court held a telephonic hearing on defendant Daniel Tepoel's motion to continue the trial date. Tepoel participated personally along with his attorney, Morris Berman. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorneys Meredith Duchemin and John Vaudreuil.

As explained at the hearing, the court was willing to give the defense three extra weeks for trial preparation, but no more. The parties agreed to this extension, then requested that we start on March 25, 2008 because of the Easter holiday. The court agreed, noting that the parties have a four-day window to try the case, after which the trial will have to adjourn until April 3, 2008 unless it concludes by March 28, 2008.

In light of the new trial date, the remaining dates were adjusted as follows:

Submissions for the final pretrial conference must be filed and served not later than March 11, 2008.

The final pretrial conference shall be March 14, 2008 at 9:30 a.m.

The final hearing before Judge Crabb shall be March 20, 2008 at 3:00 p.m.

Jury selection and trial shall begin Tuesday, March 25, 2008 at 9:00 a.m. The parties are confident that this trial will take the remainder of that week.
