Petitioner Norman Foster, a prisoner at the Jackson Correctional Institution in Black River Falls, Wisconsin, has submitted a proposed complaint. He requests leave to proceed <u>in</u> <u>forma pauperis</u>. A decision on the request will be delayed until petitioner pays an initial partial payment of the filing fee as required by 28 U.S.C. § 1915(b) and the 1996 Prison Litigation Reform Act. Petitioner's initial partial payment cannot be calculated at this time because the trust fund account statement he submitted with his complaint does not cover the full six-month period immediately preceding the filing of his complaint.

Petitioner's complaint was submitted on April 18, 2008. His trust fund account statement should cover the period beginning approximately October 18, 2007 and ending approximately April 18, 2008.

#### ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that petitioner may have until May 13, 2008, in which to submit a trust fund account statement for the period beginning approximately October 18, 2007 and ending approximately April 18, 2008. If, by May 13, 2008, petitioner fails to respond to this order, I will assume that he wishes to withdraw this action voluntarily and, in that case, the clerk of court is directed to close this file without prejudice to petitioner's filing his case at a later date.
