A telephone hearing on the substance of a proposed protective order was held in this case on February 11, 2009, before United States District Judge Barbara B. Crabb. Both parties participated by counsel. The only issue is whether defendant Lorman can withhold its customer list from disclosure until the court has decided the pending motions for class certification and defendant's motion to dismiss.

After hearing argument from counsel, I am persuaded that defendant should not have to turn over its customer list at this time. The parties will not be prejudiced if the customer list remains confidential until after the pending motions have been decided.

The parties agreed to work on a new version of the protective order, setting forth sufficient information to allow the court to find good cause to enter the protective order, as

well as incorporating the ruling on the customer list.
