In a December 9, 2008 order, I denied plaintiff Christine Porter leave to proceed on her discrimination claims because she presented no allegations of unequal treatment based on race, sex, age or disability. In addition, I declined to exercise supplemental jurisdiction over her state law medical malpractice claims because I dismissed her federal discrimination

claims. Now plaintiff has filed a somewhat confusing document in which she states that she wants the court to reopen the case or alternatively, “get this filed in Wisc. court.” Also, she states that she wants the court to contact “Action Law,” a law firm in Milwaukee, about representing her.

I will deny plaintiff’s request to reopen this case because there is nothing to reopen; I have already dismissed her complaint for failure to set forth allegations raising a federal claim. Plaintiff remains free to bring her malpractice claims in state court, but the court will not contact law firms on her behalf about representing her in that case. She will have to contact the firms for herself to determine whether a lawyer is willing to represent her.

#### ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff Christine Porter’s motion to reopen this case is DENIED.
