Petitioner has not submitted the \$5 filing fee or requested leave to proceed in forma pauperis.

Accordingly, the court will take no action on the petition unless petitioner submits

either the filing fee or a motion to proceed in forma pauperis accompanied by an affidavit of

indigency and a trust account statement from the institution by December 30, 2008. If she fails

to do so, her petition will be dismissed for her failure to prosecute it.
