On July 25, 2008, this court held a recorded telephonic hearing on plaintiff's motion for entry of a protective order. *See* Dkt. 35. Both sides were represented by counsel.

Having read all the submissions and having discussed the dispute with both sides, I denied the motion. Instead, I accepted defendant's version of the disputed protective order paragraph. Specifically, the court is imposing a one-year patent prosecution bar on experts retained by either party in this case. That said, I leave it to the parties to negotiate the details of how this will affect their choice and use of experts. If they have additional disputes that they cannot resolve between themselves, they promptly should approach the court.

The protective order is in place and effective immediately. For completeness's sake, however, the parties should submit a clean version of the order accepted by the court to be docketed into the case file.

The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention.
