Following a bench trial on January 12, 2009, this court found defendant Jeffrey A. Leys guilty of the charge of trespass charged against him in the December 23, 2008 information under Monroe County Ordinance 20-10, as adopted by 18 U.S.C. § 13(a). Following a sentencing hearing, I imposed a fine of \$75 and the statutorily required \$10 special assessment, agreed to earmark the fine for the Crime Victims Fund, *see* [www.ojp.usdoj.gov/ovc](http://www.ojp.usdoj.gov/ovc), then advised defendant of his right to appeal.

It is ORDERED that not later than February 13, 2009, defendant Jeffrey A. Leys shall pay a fine of \$75 and a special assessment of \$10 to the Clerk of Court for the Western District of Wisconsin.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of Court shall earmark this fine for the Crime Victims Fund.
