PRETRIAL MOTION
HEARING ORDER

On June 5, 2008, this court held a telephonic pretrial motion hearing. Defendant Brian Underwood did not participate personally, but was represented by his attorney, Kelly Welsh. Defendant Holly King did not participate personally, but was represented by her attorney, Robert Ruth. The government was represented by Assistant United States Attorney David Reinhard.

Prior to the hearing neither defendant filed any pretrial motions for reasons explained in letters filed by each defense attorney. *See* Dkts. 14 and 17. King filed a discovery demand which prompted a discovery proffer from the government. I set a June 30, 2008 disclosure deadline for government expert witnesses with a reciprocal expert disclosure deadline of July 14, 2008 for defendant King. The parties had no other matters to bring to the court's attention. Because both defendants predict that trial is unlikely, I will wait to provide draft

voir dire and jury instructions until closer to the parties' submission deadline for the final pretrial conference.
