ORDER

On January 29, 2014, defendant filed a motion to reduce the amount of the fine imposed on defendant under the terms of the plea agreement, dkt. #84, saying that under the terms of the plea agreement, he had agreed to the liquidation of a poster collection, with the proceeds to be applied to defendant's fine. In support of the motion, defendant has provided documentation showing that the poster collection has been sold but that the amount has not been applied to his fine.

The government agrees with defendant. It appears that the proceeds from the sale of the posters were erroneously deposited into the United States Treasury Forfeiture Fund instead of the Fine Fund. The government states that it is processing the necessary paperwork to have the \$17,700 deposited into the correct fund and applied to defendant's fine.

ORDER

Defendant's motion to reduce the fine amount under the terms of the plea agreement, dkt. #84, is DENIED as moot.
