ORDER

After considering the government's motion to continue the trial for defendants Beck and Thomas, I am denying the motion. At this time it is impossible to know whether co-defendant Jarrell A. Murray will be found competent to stand trial or whether defendant Lamar Liggons will be arrested. Rather than continue to hold defendants Thomas and Beck in custody, along with prospective witness Michael Simmons, I believe it is better to proceed with the trial even with the possibility that it might be necessary to hold additional trials in the future.
