Plaintiff Illumina, Inc., has moved the court to stay the clerk of court's taxation of costs pending appeal and to reverse the clerk's decision to award defendant Affymetrix, Inc. all of its costs copying costs. Specifically, plaintiff wants the copying costs reduced by \$112,285.01, which was the cost of converting electronic documents from one format to

another. The motion will be denied.

Plaintiff has not shown that the clerk erred in any respect in declining to delay entry of the order of costs or including the cost of conversion of electronic documents as taxable costs. As the clerk explained, the prompt taxation of costs promotes efficiency and the law in this circuit supports the granting of costs for electronic document conversion.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff Illumina, Inc.'s motion to stay the taxation of costs pending appeal and to reduce the award of costs by \$112,285.01 is DENIED.
