ORDER

On June 21, 2010, I remanded this case to the Commissioner for further proceedings. On October 1, 2010, I granted the parties' joint stipulation to award plaintiff attorney fees under the Equal Access to Justice Act in the amount of \$7,000.

Now before the court is plaintiff Julianne R. Pickett-Piltz's motion pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 406(b) asking this court to approve the payment of attorney fees by the Social Security Administration to her attorney, Dana Duncan, in the amount of \$5,611.75. This amount represents 25 percent of plaintiff's past-due benefits awarded by the Social Security Administration, less \$7,000 in attorney fees that this court awarded previously to Duncan pursuant to the Equal Access to Justice Act, 28 U.S.C. § 2412(d). The Commissioner does not oppose this motion.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that plaintiff Julianne R. Pickett-Piltz's motion for an order approving an award of attorney fees pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 406(b) is GRANTED. Plaintiff's attorney, Dana Duncan, is entitled to attorney fees in the amount of \$5,611.75, which represents 25 percent of plaintiff's past-due benefits awarded by the Social Security Administration, less \$7,000 in attorney fees that this court awarded previously to Duncan under the Equal Access to Justice Act, 28 U.S.C. § 2412(d).
