In an order entered on February 28, 2011, I told defendant Angel Servin that if he wanted to pursue the return of money allegedly taken from his apartment during a search by law enforcement officers, he would have to do so by filing a civil action and that, if he could not pay the filing fee for such an action, he would have to submit a trust fund account statement covering the six-month period beginning approximately July 10, 2010 and ending approximately January 10, 2011, which is the day before he filed his motion. I told him that if he did not do this by March 16, 2011, I would assume that he had decided not to pursue the return of his money.

Defendant did not respond to the February 28 order. Accordingly, I assume that he is not interested in going forward on a claim for the return of his money and I will dismiss his motion.
