In an order entered in this case on July 23, 2010, I directed each plaintiff to advise the court no later than August 13, 2010 whether he wished to prosecute this action. In addition, I ordered that any plaintiff who opted to proceed with the action would have until August 13 in which to submit a trust fund account statement for the period beginning December 14, 2009 and ending June 14, 2010. Finally, I stated that any plaintiff who failed to respond to the July 23 order, or who advised the court that he does not want to remain a party to the complaint would be considered to have opted out of the lawsuit and would be dismissed without owing a filing fee.

At this point, because none of the plaintiffs have submitted a trust fund account statement or complied with the July 23 order, this case will be dismissed.

## ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that this case is DISMISSED without prejudice for the plaintiffs' failure to prosecute it.
